Distance......................................... 0.5 miles (one way)
Elevation............................... $4440-4760$ feet
Snow Free ........................... May to October

Trail Highlights: This short multi-use trail takes visitors to the summit of Rocky Butte.

Trail Description: This trail begins at Forest Road 4812 and ends at Rocky Butte. From Forest Road $4812\left(4,440^{\prime}\right)$ the trail heads north uphill to Rocky Butte ( $4,760^{\prime}$ ). Nice views are found on top of Rocky Butte.

Directions to Trailhead: From the Dalles, travel south on OR Hwy 197 for 30 miles to Tygh Valley. From the Tygh Valley take Wamic Market Road to Wamic. At the south end of Wamic, turn right on White River Road (Forest Road 48). Follow White River Road to Forest Road 4810. Turn north on Forest Road 4810 and follow it 6.7 miles to Forest Road 4811. Turn right on Forest Road 4811 and travel 0.15 miles to Forest Road 4812. Turn left (west) onto 4812 and travel 0.75 mile to the trailhead parking on the right (north) side of the road.
From Portland, travel 30 miles east of Sandy on US Hwy 26 and exit onto OR Hwy 35. Head north on OR Hwy 354.7 miles, approximately 100 feet east of milepost 62, to White River Road (Forest Road 48). Turn right (south) on White River Road and travel 19 miles to Forest Road 4810. Turn north on Forest Road 4810 and travel 6.7 miles to Forest Road 4811. Turn right on Forest Road 4811 and travel 0.15 miles to Forest Road 4812. Turn left (west) onto 4812 and travel 0.75 mile to the trailhead parking on the right (north) side of the road.
