

Casey Creek Trail #476



Recreation Opportunity Guide

Distance..... 1.8 miles (one way)
Elevation..... 1600-4000 feet
Snow Free June to October



Most Difficult



Trail Highlights: This trail is in the Mark O. Hatfield Wilderness Area. There are several views once on the Nick Eaton Ridge.

Trail Description: This trail runs from Herman Creek Trail #406 to Nick Eaton Trail #447. From #406 (1,600') the trail heads up a steep hill for approximately 1 mile before reaching a ridge (2,880'). The trail continues to climb 0.8 mile to the trail's end at Nick Eaton Trail #447.

Regulations & Leave No Trace Information:

- Group size is limited to 12. Stock are counted in the group size. For example, 3 people riding their own horse plus a spare horse in the group for packing would make a group of 7.

Leave No Trace

- Plan Ahead and Prepare: Prepare for extreme weather, hazards and emergencies.
- Travel and Camp on Durable Surfaces: Use established trails and campsites.
- Dispose of Waste Properly: Pack out all trash, leftover food and litter.
- Leave What You Find: Avoid introducing or transporting non-native species.
- Minimize Campfire Impacts: Use established fire rings & keep fires small.
- Respect Wildlife: Control pets at all times.
- Be Considerate of Other Visitors: Avoid loud voices and noises.

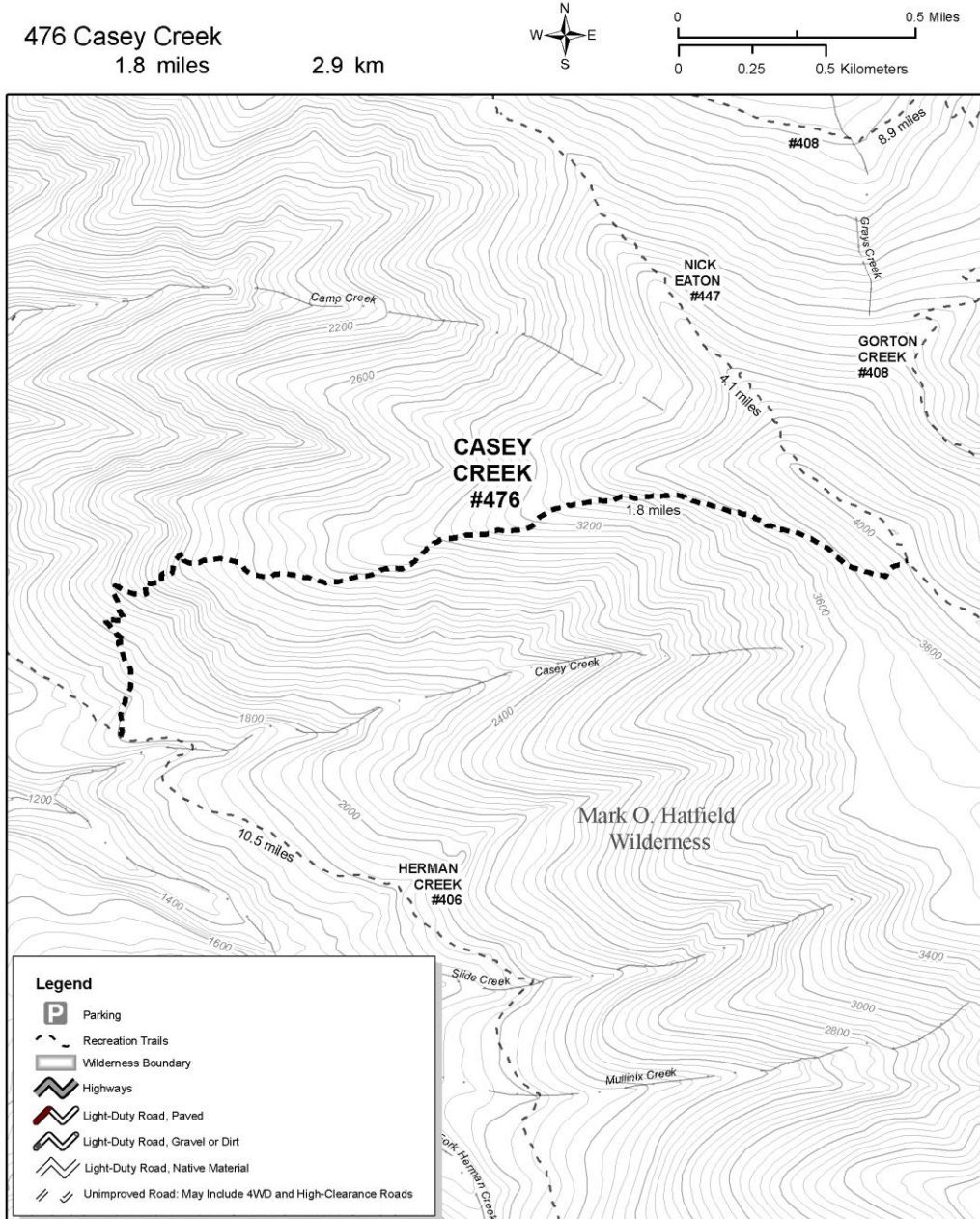

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Directions to Trailhead: Eastbound US Hwy 1-84 - Take Cascade Locks exit # 44. Drive under US Hwy 1-84 and through the town of Cascade Locks for 1.8 miles to the eastbound entrance ramp. At the stop sign, cross the road and drive east 1.6 miles toward Oxbow Fish Hatchery, then on to Herman Creek Campground. To reach #476, take the Herman Creek Trail #406 at the west end of the Campground past Herman Camp about 2.5 miles to the west end of this trail (#476).
Westbound US Hwy 1-84 - Take Herman Creek exit # 47. Drive 0.6 mile west on Forest Lane to Herman Creek Campground. The trailhead is at the west end of the Herman Creek Campground. To reach #476, take the Herman Creek Trail #406 at the west end of the Campground past Herman Camp about 2.5 miles to the west end of this trail (#476).
