

# WAHCLELLA FALLS



## MODERATE ACCESS

**Location:** Multnomah County, Ore.

**Latitude:** 45.61778 N

**Longitude:** 121.95111 W

### Directions:

**From** Portland, Oregon

Take **I-84 E/US-30 E** to **The Dalles**

Take exit **40** toward **Bonneville Dam**

Turn right at **NE Bonneville Way**

Sharp left at **Star Route**

Take the 1st right onto **Nat for Dev Rd 777/Tanner Creek Rd**



**From the Falls parking lot, hike up the road, past the foot bridge for the next 1 mile, suggest you take the trail to the upper trail going in the lower trail across the bridge coming out.**

**37.1 mi – about 46 mins**

The falls were named in 1915, by the Mazamas, after a nearby Native American village near Beacon Rock on the Washington side of the Columbia River. The USGS, however, still recognizes the falls as Tanner Creek Falls.

Elevation: 454 feet

Height: 127 feet

Magnitude: 60.61
